### COLLECT for The Third Sunday after Trinity

God our saviour, look on this wounded world in pity and in power; hold us fast to your promises of peace won for us by your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ.

***“Awake, north wind, and come, south wind! Blow on my garden, that its fragrance may spread everywhere. Let my beloved come into his garden and taste its choice fruits”. Songs of Solomon 4:16***

A strange verse for me to share one might well think when we are in a preaching series on kingdom faith in Luke’s gospel? But this week we are meditating on being ‘sent ones’ (see our Bible reading) and I feel we are called to pray this scripture over one another. You have been tending ‘gardens’ in your homes, streets, workplaces, schools and shops and hospitals as you’ve been planting seeds of conversations, playing your part on one of our church teams and wherever you share Jesus and His righteousness.

*‘Holy Spirit would you blow on each one of our ‘gardens’, may Your fragrance spread through schools, offices, shops, factories, studios, GP surgeries, hospitals that Jesus our Beloved is welcome there to taste its choice fruits’.*

If the people of God hide their lights under a bushel in the neighbourhood, at work, at recreation, other voices fill the vacuum, you never have neutrality, all are needed. We are the people of God and carry the beautiful fragrance of Christ into all those unique places the Holy Spirit has led us. You are God’s Kingdom solution for your patch of His garden. Together let’s plant well, sowing seeds and reaping a harvest of good work and lives transformed for eternity. Come Holy Spirit and blow afresh on us today! Jesus, our beloved, we welcome you.

## **BIBLE READINGS**

### **Luke 10: 1-11, 16-20**

1 After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. 2 He told them, ‘The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. 3 Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. 4 Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road. 5 ‘When you enter a house, first say, “Peace to this house.” 6 If someone

who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. 7 Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house. 8 ‘When you enter a town and are welcomed, eat what is offered to you. 9 Heal those there who are ill and tell them, “The kingdom of God has come near to you.” 10 But when you enter a town and are not welcomed, go into its streets and say, 11 “Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: the kingdom of God has come near.” 16 ‘Whoever listens to you listens to me; whoever rejects you rejects me; but whoever rejects me rejects him who sent me.’ 17 The seventy-two returned with joy and said, ‘Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name.’ 18 He replied, ‘I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven. 19 I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you. 20 However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.’
